The Australian Symposium on Ultrasound and Regional Anaesthesia Program consisted of five International Lecture Speakers, and one Australasian Lecture Speakers. The Program also offered a number of hands on workshops and master classes for everyone, discussing a range of issues for Anaesthetists.

The Symposium was successful in achieving delegate numbers of 423, and was well supported by a number of sponsors and exhibitors.

Delegates traveled from various locations around Australia and New Zealand, along with a small contingent from overseas.

Over two afternoons, over 200 workshops were conducted covering basic skills to master classes with the invited lecture speakers. A total of 30 rooms were used at Sheraton on the Park for the Symposium workshop program.

The variety of hand on workshops conducted by 50 facilitators meant that delegates could tailor their program to their experience.

With seamless organisation, excellent venues and facilities, a wide-ranging scientific program and workshops of the highest order, the Symposium was deemed to be an overwhelming success.
