ESA Clinical Epilepsy Course – 22nd February 2013 ANZAN EEG Course - 23rd and 24th February 2013 *Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne*

Course Aims

ESA Clinical Epilepsy Course

The ESA Epilepsy Course is a case-based workshop focusing on the practical management of common and sometimes difficult problems in the care of paediatric and adult patients with epilepsy. This year the focus will be on common clinical problems faced by doctors working in hospitals.

ANZAN EEG Course

The ANZAN EEG Course provides a theoretical and practical background to the reading and reporting of routine EEG and provides hands-on experience in the reading, optimal display and interpretation of normal and abnormal EEG. It serves as a foundation for future training but also provides an understanding of EEG that will be beneficial to those ordering EEG in their clinical practice.

Target Audience

ESA Clinical Epilepsy Course

Neurology trainees and neurologists in clinical practice.

ANZAN EEG Course

Neurology trainees with and without experience in EEG. Neurologists wishing to refresh, update or enhance their skills in EEG.

Format

ESA Clinical Epilepsy Course

Eight sessions, each beginning with one or more cases presented by an epileptologist followed by discussion in small groups under the direction of a table facilitator, whole audience discussion and then a summary of the key points by the presenter. Course material will be provided.

ANZAN EEG Course

The course will be held over two days. There will be four sessions on each day, each devoted to a major topic. Each session will begin with a lecture for 20-30 minutes. Participants will then break into small groups, each with their own workstation, at which EEG samples will be demonstrated and discussed under the leadership of an instructor. Tutorial groups will be graded according to experience.

UCB Australia Interstate Trainee Support Package

UCB Australia has offered financial support for neurology *trainees* approved by the Course Directors to attend from interstate.

ANZAN EEG Course

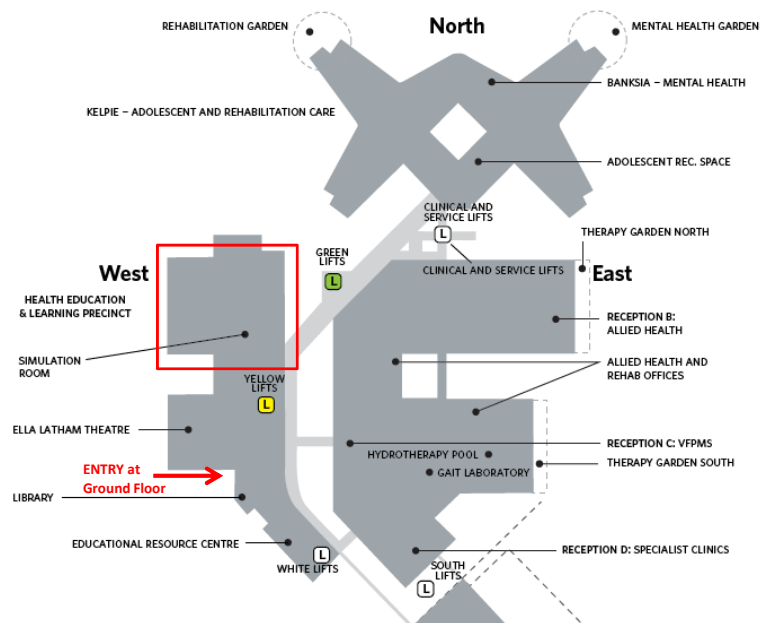
